Internships are unpaid positions. During the summer months, internships generally vary in length. During the academic year (September to May), internships generally cover the student's semester, from September to December, in the Fall, or January to May, in the Spring. Both part-time and full-time internships are available.

Interns applying to the DC office must be highly motivated, have strong communication skills, both written and verbal, and possess a keen interest in the legislative process. Duties include attending legislative hearings and community meetings, participating in regular office meetings, conducting legislative research, giving tours of the Capitol Building to visiting 45th District residents, and responding to constituent inquiries and phone calls.
